Your details were given to me by Dominic Blake at the BBC. I understand you lost your father, Stan Carby, following unsatisfactory treatment at Gosport War Memorial Hospital.

We are a charity which is supporting families who lost relatives at the hospital. As you may know an Inquest is due to be held into 10 of the deaths, starting in March. However, we are endeavouring to keep other families informed of developments also, and provide them with the opportunity to feed in information.

We will write to you again when there are any further developments, but in the meantime do not hesitate to contact me or a member of my team: Louise Price or Gillian Savage in our Advice and Information Department. It would be useful to know if you have had any contact with the General Medical Council or Nursing and Midwifery Council concerning your father's treatment.
