Re Gosport - enquiries

We have asked families to come forward and contact us if their relatives may have been treated by Dr Barton in the critical period 1996 - 2000; as far back as 1991 may still be relevant.

In view of the uncertainty as to numbers at this stage, if you get any calls we are just taking contact details to register their interests and in a few days we will look at the pattern of enquires to see if there is any scope for them to proceed as a group.

Six families who were left out of the inquest have contacted us previously and completed questionnaires for us giving their details. If they have already done a questionnaire for Blake Laphorn you can reassure them that we already have their details, although it may be worth taking their names and telephone numbers so we can double check.

If you speak with any potential clients as an enquiry about this, you do not need to go into detail as to what happened but the following information is important:

- 1 Name of deceased**
- 2 Name of family's representative (ie most likely the caller's name) - telephone number and address**
- 3 Date of death of the deceased (year will do if they are not sure)**
- 4 Were they treated in Gosport War Memorial Hospital?**
- 5 Were they treated by Dr Barton?**
- 6 Was their case investigated by the police. If so, do they know which of the three categories of concern they were placed in (category 3 was the most serious)**

Naturally please can you note the information down so that we can collate it.
