At 1123 hours that morning again in company with Detective Constable **Code A** we commenced a further tape recorded interview with Dr. BARTON in the presence of her solicitor. This interview was concluded at 1143 hours and the sealed master tape is available with an identification reference of CSY/JAB/2 .

At 1306 hours that afternoon in company with Detective Constable **Code A** we commenced a third tape recorded interview with Dr. BARTON in the presence of her solicitor. During this interview Dr. BARTON presented and read through another prepared statement which she signed and handed to DC **Code A** . This prepared statement is available with an identification reference of JB/PS/2 . The interview was concluded at 1329 hours and the sealed master tape is available with an identification reference of CSY/JAB/3 .

All three of the interviews were conducted in an office of the Fraud Squad at the Police Support HQ at Netley , Southampton and were conducted in accordance with the codes of practice on tape recorded interviews. Dr. BARTON had attended voluntarily for these interviews in company with her solicitor and had not been under arrest so was therefore free to leave at any
