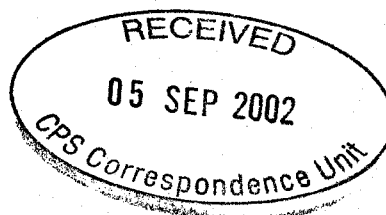

Re: Gosport War Memorial Hospital

In response to your letter dated 19th August 2002, I would like to say that I was not only disappointed but concerned with your statement that these alleged unlawful killings are not in the public interest.

The Doctor concerned continues to be allowed to practice on the elderly, even after the release of the Commission for Health Improvement's report. In my opinion the doctor was practising under the Wessex guidelines, which is not legal when the patient is not terminally ill, as my Mother was not. For you to say that such cruelty is of no concern to the public is disgraceful.

I will continue to demand justice for innocent patients like my Mother, who were unable to fight against the cruelty they were exposed to.

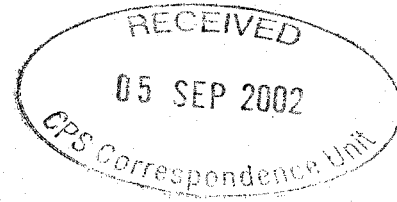
