Re: Arthur CUNNINGHAM, Code A D.O.B:12.03.19

A note to let you know I am hoping to discharge Mr. Cunningham from day hospital. His blood pressure has come down nicely now and today it was 155/75 seated. I will be checking his U's and E's today and will let you know the result in due course. We have also found during this admission that he is diabetic, but this is being controlled by diet only. His Parkinson's disease has generally been less troublesome. It may simply be the social interaction at day hospital that has helped him. I think he does have a mild ACE induced cough but he finds this tolerable.

His medication at present is Sinemet 275 1 tablet taken at approximately 06.00, 10.30, 15.00, 19.00 and midnight; Selegiline 10mg in the morning; Ranitidine 150mg nocte; Gaviscon when required; Enalapril 7.5mg in the morning.

Please refer him back if you run into any difficulties. It would be nice if possible to check his renal function every three to six months.
