Thank you for your letter regarding Mr. Cunningham. He has been undergoing E.S.W.L. for a right renal calculus which was 2cm in size originally. Following seven sessions on the lithotripter the size of the stone reduced to 15 mm and beyond this treatment did not reduce the size of the stone any further. He has hitherto undergone nine sessions of lithotripsy and I did explain to Mr. Cunningham that it may be unlikely that E.S.W.L. will help him any further. He is due for a further KUB x-ray in two weeks time at which stage we will probably discharge him from further treatment. I hope this information suffices.
