Thank you for seeing this 70 year old man who has not felt well for the last 9 weeks. He has no appetite, feels nauseous although he has no abdominal pain. He has lost about a stone in weight in the last year. He used to drink very heavily and still drinks 4 units of alcohol a day and he is an ex smoker of 40 cigarettes a day. His bowel action has also become loose - he opens his bowels now 5 times a day.

On examination he is obese, there is no obvious lymphadenopathy, no tenderness or masses palpable in the abdomen and rectal examination revealed a soft dark brown stool, but not melena.

I am obviously concerned that he has a peptic ulcer or carcinoma and I would be grateful for your help with investigation. I have warned him that he is still drinking too much alcohol but he is reluctant to change this and I have initiated some simple investigations.
