Thank you for taking Mrs 87 year old lady who has deteriorated over the past 5 days. She has become more vague, not eating or drinking. She is sleeping a lot and has fallen several times. She was seen by my locum on 26.1.98 when she was showing symptoms of depression, feeling guilty, no energy, having to be depressed - wishing to die. I saw her Monday when again I felt she was depressed. She seemed much more subdued than usual and 'flat'.

She has worsened since then and now seems physically ill. She now has to be fed - encouraged to drink.

She has longstanding atrial fibrillation and CHF. She is on the following medication. Aspirin 325mg BD, furosemide 40mg OD, Ranitidine 150mg OD, Digoxin <sup>125</sup> ~~125~~ ~~125~~ OD (2.50-5mg OD) aspirin 75mg OD. statins 40mg OD.

She looks unwell.
