# Gosport Investigation

## Complaint

#### Mrs R

### Summary

Complaint by daughter about delay in dealing with mothers' fall, delay in x-ray results and transfer arrangements.

Second daughter subsequently raised concerns with police.

### Chronology

July 1998 Admitted Haslar from nursing home, following a fall.

August 1998 Transferred to Daedalus for slow mobilisation

- 13 August Falls no apparent injury. Later right hip noted to be internally rotated. Analgesia given over night.
- 14 August Xray at GWMH confirms dislocation. Transfer to Haslar for relocation.
- 17 August Returned from Haslar to GWMH, no nurse escort or trolley canvass for lifting. In pain and distressed
- 18 August Pain control via syringe driver. Dr Barton believed daughters to agree with decision not to undertake further surgery as haematoma formed on site of reduction.
- 21 August Mrs R dies

### Trust Action

Review of "policy" not to transfer patients to Haslar A&E outside of working hours.

Review nursing record and documentation Further training on record and documentation for all staff Review of marking of clothing "policy"
