

Telephone conversation with Mrs McKenzie

12.04.02

Mrs McKenzie rang to update Julie on recent events that she felt were important to the investigation.

- The relatives that complained to the police have met with Mrs McKenzie and spoke about how they were not interviewed by the police as next of kin and the medical files of their relatives were not read.
- Mrs McKenzie has compared the notes of her mother's file and **Code A** file and found written errors. The errors have included notes written about Mrs Richards in **Code A** medical notes. **Code A** notes also contained a recorded time of death of Mrs Richards.
- Mrs McKenzie spoke to John James and the police suggested that the pages may have been muddled up. But Mrs McKenzie argued that the file notes were made in the middle of drug notes and note just on individual sheets.
- John James spoke to Mrs McKenzie and explained that the police did not go through the individual files.
- Mrs McKenzie also mentioned another relative that has written about his fathers death and asked the police questions such as 'Do you put a patient with dementia on diamorphine?'
