She has nothing but praise for the care and attention her mother was given. She too was on diamorphine but as far as **Code A** is concerned she was not given too much, she was only given enough to allow her to "die with dignity".

All the staff on the ward were extremely caring at all times both to **Code A** and to her two daughters and son.
