The largest ethnic group is 'White' (98.3% for Fareham & Gosport)

72% of people in Fareham and 69% of people in Gosport described their health in the past 12 months as being 'good'.

15% of people in Fareham and 17% of people in Gosport indicated that they had a limiting long-term illness.

2% of people in Fareham and 3% of people in Gosport are unemployed. Within Fareham 23% of those unemployed were aged 50 and over, 4% had never worked and 22% were long term unemployed. Within Gosport, 17% of those unemployed were aged 50 and over, 7% had never worked and 24% were long term unemployed.
