I feel my mother should have  
been moved to a medical ward  
a lot sooner than she was. She  
suffered great pain before her death  
which I feel she need not have.

My family kept talking to the nurses  
and asking how our mother was, I  
was told she just needs a rest.  
She is a bit depressed. "we have  
watched how she gets on with  
her husband and he is making her low"

In the end after seeing our mother going from bad to worse the whole family tried to get her moved to a hospital that could help her. She had not eaten or drunk anything for days and nobody was doing a thing about it. After lots of phone calls all over the place we got the news she was going to be moved. I was on the ward when Dr Knapman came on to see my mother, he did not examine her or anything he just told me she would be moved sometime today. I spoke to Dr Knapman in the corridor and I asked if she was going to be OK, "Probably not" was his reply then he started telling me how she would not be getting her heart operation! I did not ask

him about that but for some reason he felt the need to have a go at me, I was in tears, hearing that my mother would "Probably not" be OK now. We waited all day for her to be moved and when she was and the Dr on blendworth ward St. Mary's hospital, told us Sorry we had to wait so long to see our mother but he was surprised she had come from another hospital because of her condition.

She was very dehydrated, she had liver + kidney failure. Her lungs were bleeding and this was on top of her heart condition + Lewkine,

firstly I would like to know the reasons why she was put onto Sultan ward. She was a

medically ill woman with heart  
Problems and Nicotina.

3. Why it took so long before she  
was moved to a suitable ward.
4. Why when she was so ill it took  
from Am until late Pm for her  
to be moved to St Marys.

I work for the N.H.S as a H.C.S.W  
for L.D.D. In my Job I report to  
a qualified nurse if a client go's  
off there food or drink within 24hrs.  
We record intake and out take quickly  
and have got clients into hospital  
very quickly when there fluid is

qualified nurse cover?

I truly believe somebody failed  
to do there job correctly and  
I would like to know who, and  
why.
