1. At present daughter visits mother on Sundays. Goes directly to chapel, and asks chapel volunteers to collect & return Code A Chapel staff are not entirely happy with this arrangement, as they are already busy collecting patients who do not have relatives visiting.

Up until Christmas daughter was visiting on the ward infrequently (weekly at most), and would go out of her way to avoid contact with nursing staff.

Code A did visit her daughter on the ward this Sunday (26/3/00). This followed telephone contact by me, to inform her of changes in Code A condition.

- 2. Code A current MTS is 3/10. Her mental state is variable, she becomes easily confused, particularly if we deviate from the routine she is used to. Previous MTS has been as low as $1\frac{1}{2}/10$
- Code A says she would like to return home. Daughter wishes Code A to 3. remain in NHS care.

Medical & Nursing opinion, is that Code A would not be able to manage at home, even with a care package, and therefore we would recommend referral for nursing or rest home.
