**1. Apologies for Absence**

**2. Minutes of the last Meeting**

**3. Matters Arising**

- I. It was noted that the Practice Manager's representation from Gosport would be shared between Jean Smith and Jane Colebourne.
- II. Terms of Reference  
 Nicky Heyworth to check if amendments have been made.
- III. Performance Indicator Working Group  
 Alan Pickering sent his apologies
- IV. GP Appraisal – GP's are undertaking appraisals of each other. There are six appraisers trained in Fareham and Gosport. It has been agreed to pay £1,000 per appraisal, including locum cover and training needs resulting from appraisal. The PCT is looking at providing contracts for appraisers.  
  
 A guide for GP appraisals will be sent out to each GP two months before their appraisal. Actual appraisal documents can be downloaded from the Department of Health website.
- V. A further meeting is required to discuss Clinical Governance Lead Group, made up of Lead GP's in each practice. The group met three times in the last two years. Appraisal will be discussed at the first meeting. Nicky Heyworth will arrange a half day meeting, with locum fee reimbursement for mid December, any ideas to be given to Nicky Heyworth or Code A

#### 4. Referral letter and Pathology Results Standardisation

Mr. Philip Scott, Head of IT, gave an overview of the standard of referral letter and pathology results currently received by those working in secondary care. In primary care, there are a number of different software packages, producing different letters. It was agreed that Andrew Neal, IT facilitator for F&G PCT and Nicky Heyworth, Clinical Governance Manager, would visit a representative practice from each software company to assess the letters currently being produced. AN and NH will liaise with Philip Scott to keep him updated, and report to the next Clinical Governance Leads Meeting.

#### 5. Violence in Primary Care

Zero tolerance initiative focusing on all areas particularly Primary Care. A Violence Sub Group has been formed – Nicky Heyworth, Rachel Boyns, Chris Kelly and Betty Woodland to discuss securing facilities for Fareham and Gosport.

The PCT is required to generate an action plan and send to Strategic Health Authority.

There will be a need to carry out risk assessments for all practices.

Suggestion made to contact Crime Reduction Officer.

There was also a discussion re: recording verbal/violent incidents.

#### 6. Trust Board Performance Indicators

#### 7. Gosport War Memorial Hospital Up-date

Noted that Professor Baker audit was under way and that the police investigation had commenced. There remain concerns re: sustaining out of hours cover to Dryad and Daedalus after 31.12.02.

Fiona Cameron, Ian Reid, Althea Lord, Margaret Smith and Neil Stubbs are working with other local providers in an attempt to resolve.

#### 8. Audit Update

CHI action plan is in its 3<sup>rd</sup> draft. Final draft should be received by the end of November, meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> November 2002 of CHI Implementation Group.

#### 9. Pharmacy Issues

PGD's were drawn up two years ago to be used in practices. Discussion regarding their use in community nursing – unresolved.

#### 10. Progress with the Caldicott Report Timetable

Code A is co-ordinating this and has sent out questionnaires. The next meeting is to be held on Monday where results of audits will be analysed and report will then be sent to Department of Health early next year.
