A series of introductory sessions – to help break down barriers and work towards Person Centred Assessment and Care Delivery, multi-grade, multi-professional target group.

An over all intention is to “leave grades outside the door”, include day and night staff, full and part-timers, include twilight staff, plus administration and support staff + service user representatives.

Format would be a series of four workshops in each PCT – first workshop would be an Introduction Session – repeated during the evening to encourage maximum interest.
