

Film festival to highlight important green issues

ENVIRONMENTAL issues will be brought to life at a new film festival being showcased in Portsmouth.

The Portsmouth Film Society will launch the city's first-ever Green Film Festival at the Omega Centre, in Omega Street, Somers Town, tomorrow evening. The festival, which starts at 6pm, will be opened by the new Lord Mayor of Portsmouth Cllr Frank Jonas.

Films which raise awareness of climate change and wildlife habitats will be shown throughout the event.

An entry fee is required for each film. A panel of environmental experts will discuss whether more can be done to protect the planet.

The festival will run at the Omega Centre on Friday and it will culminate the next day at Victoria Park, Portsmouth, where all the films are going to be aired for free.

Aysegul Epengin, chairwoman of The Portsmouth Film Society said: 'I'm really looking forward to the festival and I hope that a lot of people will turn up to see the films. It's exciting because it's going to be a first for Portsmouth.'

Campaigner welcomes inquest after 14 years

Date set for hearing into pensioner's hospital death

SHE has waited and campaigned for 14 long years.

And now Gillian MacKenzie has welcomed the news that she will at last be able to attend an inquest into the death of her mother.

Gladys Richards, 91, died at Gosport War Memorial Hospital in 1998.

Hers was one of a string of deaths there that sparked police investigations.

An inquest into her death will start on December 5, as previously reported in *The News*.

The date has come after relentless campaigning from Mrs Mackenzie, 78.

She said: 'It's been a long struggle to even get a date settled. That's considering my inquest was granted by Jack Straw in January 2009 and it was supposed to be heard with other cases at the time.'

'Then it was hived off separately and it's taken all this

time to get a date settled and I find that extraordinary.'

'I don't think it will be delayed this time, even though it has been postponed so many times before.'

Mrs Richards was taken to the Royal Haslar Hospital after she suffered a fall in

Glen Heathers care home where she had been staying.

After her operation, Mrs Richards was transferred to Gosport War Memorial Hospital, in Bury Road, for rehabilitation.

During the course of her treatment she was given pain-

killers.

She died under the care of Dr Jane Barton.

Following Mrs Richards' death, her daughter approached police with concerns over her mother's care.

It was this case that prompted an investigation by Hampshire Constabulary into deaths at the hospital.

Inquests into the deaths of five other patients at the hospital took place in 2009.

A jury ruled that drugs prescribed by Dr Barton contributed to the deaths.

Last year, Dr Barton's application to have her name removed from the General Medical Council register was accepted - she will not be able to practise in the UK.

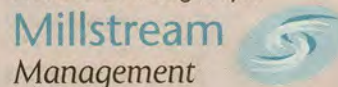
