The instructions for X-ray - Drips - Keeping still, etc have been exhausting for all not least Mum who could not hear any of the Doctors explanations and cried out in fear.

We have wanted to move Mum for some considerable time but felt the usual would be unfair as she was familiar on a day to day basis with her surroundings.

Following interview with Pauline, Consultant to Glen Cove Homes.

Several statements were read out to us confirming that Mum was walked. It also told us the fall was in the Dining room at 2.50pm. What was she doing still in the dining room?? Frequently those sitting quietly following 2 noon lunch are left in this room. If Mum was left - she would have got up to go to the loo. The statements show she was walked from Dining room to lounge they also show she was walked from lounge to bedroom obviously in pain. We do not know what time this was. At no time was a Dr's opinion sought.
