

Mother's admission sheet 11. 8. 98. Written by Dr Barton.

States NVR in obvious pain yet Oramorph is prescribed.
Also "transfers with hoist" is not correct as she was transferring with help and use of Zimmer frame.
 Also statement "I am happy for nursing staff to confirm death".
 This for a patient referred for rehabilitation following surgery.
 Oramorph commenced on 11. 8. 98 and given on 11. 12. 13
 & 14th of August. In this time I only saw her conscious twice,
 on 14th transferred back to Haslar following a fall 24 hrs
 earlier. Back in Haslar following manipulation of hip joint.
 Mother enjoys food & drink. No drugs or analgesia necessary or
 given. Able to converse conscious throughout her stay. Eating & drinking.
 Transfer back to G.W.M.H on 17th. 08 98 around midday
 Oramorph again given. Although prescribed hourly she is
 given lt doses i.e. ^{several} ~~her~~ ^{which were documented} ~~repeated~~ plus 2 Intramuscular injections which are not recorded but were witnessed - all
 of which rendered her unconscious. - NVR able to have
 hydration or nourishment. My mother did not regain
 consciousness ^{again} but was in a coma induced state.
 She was again given Oramorph twice on the 18th and a
 syringe draw with Diamorphine together with Haloperidol
 and Hizazepam. Were administered continually until her
 death - She was unable to have any nourishment and
 only her strong constitution and previous good diet allowed
 her to live until the 21st August. '98

I did not see my mother on her feet once, since
 admission, and she was in a drug induced coma
 continuously from 17 to 21st August.
