 This entry on admission from Haslar.  
 3rd paragraph. Not obviously in pain - and yet oramorph was prescribed on this day.  
 5th Para/line. I am happy for nursing staff to confirm death. - This is in direct contrast to the discharge introductory letter AF/1/c/1 from Haslar.
