

Mother's Admission Sheet. 11.8.98. Write by Dr Barton. states "Not in obvious pain" yet prescribed Oramorph. Also I am happy for nursing staff to commence on Oramorph ^{on admission} ^{confidentially!}
 Given on 11th 12th & 13th Aug. On 13th Mother fell.

and on 14th Aug. she was again given Oramorph. Then transferred back to Hasla with dislocation of new hip joint
 Back in Hasla. 14. 15. 16. Conscious. Able to take drink & food. Able to mobilise. Able to converse well. following a manipulation of the joint in casualty.

Transfer to G.W.M.H. again on 17th at around midday.

Oramorph. again administered. Although

- prescribed 4hrly she was given 4 doses within a 5 hour period. ^{and intramuscular injections continuously were administered} which rendered her unconscious.

My Mother did not regain consciousness again following the Oramorph which was again given on the 18th twice she then had Diamorphine via a syringe drawn ^{from the 18th} together with Haloperidol and another drug. continuously until she died.
 (Midazolam)

- She was therefore rendered unable to be hydrated or take any nourishment during this period which led to an induced death.

I did not see my mother on her feet once following her admission and she was deeply unconscious 17 18 19 20 & 21st August '98
