RE: GWMH – MRS E.I. PAGE

This morning I received a reply from the IPCC (Independent Police Complaints Commission), with the provisional Commission's decision "that misconduct proceedings cannot be justified". Previous correspondence confirms that this investigation was completed in April 2003, and having been endorsed by DCC I. Readhead was passed on to the (then) PCA. That was twenty seven months ago!

It is a lengthy document and requires further perusal and clarification of certain statements made, before I reply within 28 days.

I would still like to see the expert's opinion in my mother's case to enable me to come to my own opinion as to what occurred during the very short period my mother was at GWMH.

Following previous advice from the police that my case would not be included in the cases being further investigated; I have received no information as to the situation regarding Operation Rochester.

I returned a telephone call to Lisa confirming my desire to be included in further civil action that was being organised for those cases that could be brought against the Health authority, that was some considerable time ago, and I have heard nothing since.

Are you able to clarify my present situation, and comment on the attached IPCC letter?
