I enclose, for your information, the expert review on my late mother's case together with a copy of my letter to Detective Inspector Niven.

I am appalled by the expert review and cannot believe that the experts can have seen all of my mother's medical records.

As you can see the expert review covers only the period from 15<sup>th</sup> August to 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2001.

My mother, who was a fit woman for her age, lived alone and was totally independent, looking after herself and others before she had a stroke on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2001. She was transferred on 29<sup>th</sup> May 2001 from Haslar to Gosport War Memorial Hospital for rehabilitation.

According to the expert review my mother was not in hospital on 31<sup>st</sup> July. In addition my mother's date of birth is quoted incorrectly - have the correct records been assessed?

If the experts have not read my complaints in conjunction with all of her medical records I feel that a correct assessment cannot be made as to my mother's care while she was in Gosport War Memorial Hospital.
