Re: Complaint against Hampshire Constabulary

Thank you for your letter dated 27th October 2005 together with the enclosure.

I regret that the first paragraph of your letter causes me great confusion in that I have not received any communication from you, other than the letter dated 27th October 2005, since my letter to you dated 2nd July 2005. I was not therefore aware that the IPCC released a press statement on 21 October 2005 and I am offended that such action has been taken without anyone having the courtesy to notify me of events.

Please, by return, provide me with ALL documents that have been put into the public domain regarding this matter and inform me as to how I can obtain a copy of the publication containing the press release that was made.

As regards the invitation to meet with the IPCC and discuss the relevant issues, I am prepared to attend on any date, apart from the 7th to 12th November 2005, between now and the end of December as this matter, together with the refusal of the Gosport & Fareham Primary Care Trust to meet and discuss the issues relating to my mother's death, is causing continuing distress and a strong feeling that the NHS are hiding information that should be available to family members and that the Police are assisting the NHS by the negligent manner in which they have "investigated" the various deaths.

I therefore confirm that I will attend the meetings, together with Mr D W Wilson who has been assisting me and who is a family member, on any date you wish between now and the end of December, apart from those mentioned above.
