My name is Iain Wilson, I am writing to you today, because like yourselves, my late father was one of the nine deaths at the Gosport War Memorial hospital that have to date, been investigated by Hampshire police.

My family and I, also have many worries and concerns, regarding the circumstances of my father's death and, indeed the care and medication given to him, in his last few days at the Gosport War Memorial.

We are also extremely disappointed with both Hampshire police and the crown prosecution service not to investigate these deaths further and also, not have widen the investigation. We believe that there are far to many questions that still need to be answered.

I have to date been in touch, just as most of you will have been, with the health authorities, the police and the commission for health improvements, I do not think any of these bodies are going to give us, as individuals, the answers that we are all looking for, and in fact I get the impression, that they would be happier if we all went away.

I for one will not go away, not until I know for sure that my Dad died a natural death, that everything was done to help him and that had he been in any other hospital that the same outcome would have occurred.

I feel that we might have a more powerful voice if we were all to join together in our quest for the truth, and it is for this reason that I am writing directly to you now. I would like to suggest that before we all go our separate ways looking for our peace of mind that it might be a good idea for us all to meet together.

I would be willing to arrange a convenient place for us to meet, and if necessary, to act as a liaison between us all. If you think that this may help and you would like to meet, please call me, my telephone number is **Code A**

I'm sorry to have approached you like this, and I really hope that I have not caused any further upset to you, but I really want to know the truth of my fathers death and I believe that we have more chance if we all work together.

I hope and look forward to hearing from you soon.
