Diagnosis: CLL, Ischaemic Heart Disease

This lady felt she should be seen and came to see me at St. Mary's. Her haemoglobin is good at 10.2 g/dl, her white count reasonable at $8.4 \times 10^9/l$ and her platelet count is still raised at $578.0 \times 10^9/l$. We have had positive occult bloods from her. The Gastroenterologists are going to see her shortly to investigate further her GI blood loss. She is extremely upset about the fact that she has been taken off the cardiology waiting list while I sort out her leukaemia. I think wires have got crossed somewhere because this was not as I understood things were going to go. I thought we would just get on and do the heart operation because frankly her inland lymphoma should not be a contraindication to surgery. I will see her again in Gosport in three weeks' time.
