I saw this lady on behalf of Mr Resouly in the ENT clinic today. I note that she was seen in October last year with a history of worsening voice.

Today she felt her voice had improved slightly and importantly she has no symptoms of dysphagia or soreness.

Clinical examination today of her nose and mouth were unremarkable. Her larynx was examined with a flexible nasendoscope and I am pleased to report that there is no evidence of a laryngeal lesion and her vocal cord movement is normal. There was a large amount of mucus present throughout the examination and I suspect therefore that she has evidence of a chronic laryngitis secondary to chronic post nasal drip.

I have treated her today with some Flixonase nasal spray and suggested steam inhalations with menthol in an attempt to dry up the chronic post nasal drip. I have not arranged to see her routinely again. I can reassure you that she has no serious laryngeal pathology.
