 Ischaemic heart disease

Mrs. Windsor is really no better than when I last saw her. Her bone marrow shows 65% has been replaced with small lymphocytes and taking this into account with her modest anaemia, I think the time has come for treatment. Dr. Cook feels that the rash she had when I last gave her Chlorambucil was in fact not due to Chlorambucil but a separate entity. I have therefore represcribed Chlorambucil 5 mg daily and Prednisolone 10 mg daily. Just to be on the safe side I have asked her to come back in two weeks' time to tell me how she is getting on.
