Diagnosis: CLL, Ischaemic Heart Disease

Her haemoglobin today was 10.0 g/dl, white cell count $3.6 \times 10^9/l$ and her platelet count has fallen a little to $407.0 \times 10^9/l$. I understand that she has had a gastroscopy and colonoscopy where they found a few minor abnormalities but nothing that would account for her anaemia. She complains today that she feels sick all the time, has a constant headache, is unable to eat and walking is difficult because of a pain in her leg. She reported to Eastbourne Hospital with the pain in her leg and they gave her a course of anti-clotting pills. Some of these symptoms could be attributable to the Chlorambucil and Prednisolone so for the next two weeks I have asked her to stop taking those drugs and instead take Ranitidine 150 mg b.d. We will review her again at the end of that time.
