Re: **Norma WINDSOR DOB:**

I would be most grateful if you could see this lady who is not normally a patient of mine. She came to see me in some desperation last week because her normal doctor was away on holiday. Essentially over the preceding 24 hours she had developed a 5cm soft tender lump in her left axilla. She also had a similar lump in the left side of her neck which was about 7cm in diameter. I organised a chest x-ray, full blood count and ESR.

Unfortunately this lady has number of other medical problems including chronic lymphatic leukaemia for which she sees Dr P Green, the haematologist. She also has a rather bizarre skin condition for which Dr Cook, the dermatologist, cannot make a diagnosis but pemphigoid has been mentioned. She also has quite severe heart disease and has had a cardiac bypass in the past.

More recently Dr Knapman, her usual GP, referred her to the ENT Department at the War Memorial Hospital because of a hoarse voice. I enclose a list of her current medication and would be grateful if you could see her as urgently as possible.
