This has left her with absolutely no energy, too tired, to do anything much for herself but we are only three week's from those episodes. While in hospital her rash disappeared altogether and has not returned, before it disappeared it was seen by John Cook who felt it was more likely to be pemphigoid and probably not related to the Chlorambucil. Her haematology is pretty much unchanged I have started her on no treatment and will check her again in one month's time.
