Mrs. Windsor attended the haematology clinic today for routine review. She continues to suffer a blistering rash which comes and goes and has recently been biopsied. She has no symptoms related to her CLL.

On examination there is a small node in the right side of her neck but no other lymphadenopathy nor hepatosplenomegaly.

Her lymph nodes appear to have responded well to a short course of Chlorambucil given 9 months' ago. She does not need treatment at present. We will see her again in three months or earlier if need be.
