Reviewing Mrs. Windsor, she unfortunately had no lesions when she attended for biopsy. She was advised to stop the Zirtek and return if the lesions did. After three days without Zirtek, the lesions appeared on the right elbow and arm and on the right knee and both ankles. Again they appear to be urticated with some vesiculation. The lesions now are not particularly fresh. She describes lesions comprising urticated plaques up to perhaps 3 to 3.5 cms with vesicles on cockade. This raises other possibilities such as linear 2gA disease.

I have arranged for histology and immunofluorescence.

Although she has been labelled as being allergic to Chlorambucil, I do not think this is the case and that should be deleted from the notes.
