Mrs. Windsor's haemoglobin has dropped by 1 g. Her white count has remained steady at 20. However she has developed a large node in her left supra-clavicular region and the other nodes in her armpits have increased in size. Her night sweats have become somewhat intolerable. She is also complaining of feeling tired and lacking in stamina. These latter two may be related to the fact she has recently had a myocardial infarct. However in view of the fact the B symptoms have not improved, I have asked her to take 5 mg. Chlorambucil daily and shall review her in six weeks' time.
