The happy side of this lady is that her haemoglobin is 13.5 g/dl, WBC 8.4 and she is feeling quite vigorous. However the down side is that she has a quite severe dermatitis as you know, of her hands and feet. It is perhaps noticeable that these are the areas that are most exposed to the sunshine. I understand from her that you have given her an antibiotic cream. I have given her some E45 sunblock lotion which I hope will get rid of the problem. I am also going to be investigating her for porphyria because that seems another possibility here.

I have given her an appointment for review in two months' time but have also given her my telephone number so if the sunblock lotion doesn't work, we can quickly think of something else to do such as sending her to see a dermatologist.
