I write in regards to your referral of the above named and further to my correspondence dated 30 March 2010.

In referring to the correspondence of 30 March 2010, a request for additional evidence was made, as unfortunately it was felt that the current information we have on file was insufficient, to allow us to formulate allegations against the specific nurses.

As no response was received from you and due to the lack of direct evidence, the decision has been made to close this case. This is because without specific evidence regarding each nurse, the case is 'not in the form required' to enable progression to our panel.

I realise that this was not the outcome you were seeking, and if you feel that you do have new evidence, the Nursing and Midwifery Council would be more than happy to re-open the matter and consider the same.

In light of our decision I am returning the documentation you sent to us. If you disagree with my decision you should write to the Interim Triage Case Manager, Mr Gary Coats, explaining your reasons as fully as possible.
