Mother in coma after X-ray 17th on return
to Gosport. Injection given by Beed just
prior to going down to X-ray, not on drug chart
Drug chart - other notes do not tally with
Zambian's comments. Mother entreats me to
'do something' prior to X-ray.
She had been transferred from Ambulance to
bed on a sheet - rolled off sheet onto
the ^{new hip} _(13.08.98) - recently dislocated again at
Gosport, 4 hours waiting for X-ray.

Code A

Beed informed my sister & myself 18th. Mother
had massive haematomas - nothing could be
done except give her pain free death. Nothing
written up on file regarding Haematomas
& no indication on X-ray or body when
she died 4 days later. Haematomas would have
shown up on skin. Told death was
imminent by Beed on 18th. Death 21.8.98

PS. Gathered same information yesterday with
Field Fisher warehouse.

When I saw Mrs Richards she was clearly confused and unable to give any coherent history. However she was pleasant and cooperative. She was able to move her left leg quite freely and although not able to actively lift her extended right leg from the bed, she appeared to have a little discomfort on passive movement of the right hip. I understand that she has been sitting out in a chair and I think that, despite her dementia, she should be given the opportunity to try to re-mobilise. I will arrange for her transfer to Gosport War Memorial Hospital. I understand that her daughters intend to give up the place in Glenheathers Nursing Home as they have been unhappy with the care, but would be happy to arrange care in another nursing home. *Told him we needed a new chair.*
