Thank you for your letter dated 29 Sep and for your concern about the untimely death of my step-father, Brian Cunningham.

For your information, I have enclosed a copy of the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death which cites Sacral Ulcer as a contributory cause of his demise. I spoke to the Chief Pathologist following a post-mortum examination which confirmed the cause of actual death as Bronchpneumonia, and he advised that it was virtually impossible to say anything else even though Mr Cunningham had absolutely no bronchial complaint when he was admitted to hospital 5 day before he died. Toxicity tests were not carried out.
