Papers supplied to you in 2001 did not include a "Statement" from Jane Barton. She was interviewed by the Police in April 2000 and immediately gave in her notice to the Health Authority 28 April 2000 leaving Gosport in July 2000. We are all well aware of the effect on diamorphine usage from the CHI Report. At the interview she was accompanied by a solicitor. Her answers to police questions consisted of "no comment" until she lost her cool with words to the effect "I do not have to put up with this" Are you sure you considered that to be a Statement?
