Dr Jane Barton: Alleged irresponsible prescribing to multiple patients at Gosport War Memorial Hospital in late 1990s.

[Redacted] Allegations of poor treatment and communication during surgery in which patient suffered haemorrhage.

[Redacted] Allegations of issuing NHS prescriptions to members of his family not entitled to receive them, and of poor care to patients of out of hours service
