- 3. I have no qualms about supporting the way that Dr Barton treated patients.
- 4. Now Gosport War Memorial Hospital has a staff grade / registrar / doctor on duty during the day following the Investigation by CHI.
- In about 1993-94 Gosport War Memorial Hospital was given a significant amount of money. The hospital was revamped and a huge extension was built. Previously there had been a male ward and a female ward and an operating theatre. These all went and there was Daedulus Ward, Dryad Ward and Sultan Ward. There was also the Dolphin and the Phoenix Day Hospitals, two mental health wards upstairs and the Blake Maternity Unit. The hospital had expanded considerably. The Out-patients Department was also bigger. The hospital had a new kitchen and the dining room was generally upgraded.
- 6. Prior to 1993-1994 there had been Redcliffe Annex. A stand alone unit but part of Gosport War Memorial Hospital. This became Dryad Ward. The patients and staff came over. Gill Hamblin was the Sister in charge of Redcliffe Annex and then subsequently Dryad Ward.
- 7. Some of the staff at Dryad Ward had been together a long time since the days of Redcliffe Annex although there were some new ones also.

- 8. I have the role of **Code A** I am there to represent nurses and attend meetings with them or disciplinary hearings. I will provide support to any member of the Royal College of Nursing who wants a representative.
- 9. At the Gosport War Memorial Hospital all the staff knew each other very well.
- 10. I have been involved in the investigations at Gosport War Memorial since the outset. I was not involved in the complaints that certain members of staff made in the early 1990s. However since the complaint made by the family of Gladys Richards, and from that time onwards I have been involved providing support to the staff.
- 11. I found Dr Barton to be a lovely lady who was very professional. Dr Lord was also a very caring lady who still keeps in touch with members of staff at Gosport War Memorial Hospital even though she is now in New Zealand.
- 12. The hospital did not have a lot of syringe drivers. There would only be one syringe driver per ward and a spare held between three wards.
- 13. Exhibited to this statement and marked Code A is a copy of the statement I gave to the Police regarding Dr Barton dated 1 February 2003. I have had a chance to re-read this and have added several words (in Red).
- 14. I understand that my statement may be used in evidence for the purposes of a hearing before the General Medical Council's Fitness to Practise Panel and for the purposes of any appeal, including any appeal by the Council for Healthcare Regulatory Excellence. I confirm that I am willing to attend the hearing to give evidence if asked to do so.

Redcliffe Annex was renamed Redcliffe House and its patients came from Knowle and Coldeast Hospitals.

In 1994 the GWMH ceased to come under the administration of the Portsmouth and South East Health Authority and came under new management in the Portsmouth Health Care NHS Trust. I found the new managers approachable and accessible; they promoted an open culture and welcomed the observations of all of the Unions who represented staff at the GWMH.

I have been asked if I was approached in any capacity by members of staff, in relation to syringe drivers and the use of diamorphine.

I was first approached in relation to these issues in 1998 when seventeen RCN members sought representation in relation to an enquiry involving a previous patient, Mrs RICHARDS.

As Code A for the hospital, normally on my weekend shifts, I had access to the hospital keys. I was aware that there were syringe drivers in the hospital because some were kept in the storeroom and occasionally I would be asked for the keys to the store in order for a syringe driver to be removed.

I have been asked if I ever attended the Redcliffe Annex as the Code A I never went down to the Redcliffe Annex, as this would have left the Code A unsupervised.

I have been asked if I received any training in their use whilst at the GWMH. I did not. This was because I did not use them during the course of my work. I had the initial training in their use when I was qualifying but as I worked entirely within the Code A I had no cause to use them, Syringe drivers were not used to administer pain relief in my department, any diamorphine given, would have been via an ordinary syringe.

I have been asked about documents relating to the use of syringe drivers and diamorphine at the GWMH in 1991.
