Thank you for your letter dated 18th December 2006 concerning the death of my step-father in 1998.

I am sincerely grateful for the strenuous efforts of the Police over the years in trying to bring this matter to a satisfactory conclusion, but am profoundly disturbed to hear of the decision of the Crown Prosecution Service which, in my opinion, is totally erroneous. I have not the slightest doubt that my step-father was intentionally and maliciously disposed of, and it is my wish that this should never be allowed to recur.

It seems to me that the Crown Prosecution Service may not have taken into account the fact that individuals such as myself are fully prepared to act as witnesses to the events leading up to the deaths of our relatives, and the impact that our personal statements would surely have on the deliberations of a jury. Indeed, I feel somewhat angry that I am being denied the opportunity, even after all this time.

I would very much appreciate an opportunity to discuss the issues fu	orther with Detective Superintendent
Williams as suggested but, in the first instance, would like to consider	
involved in the ten cases you mention. I would therefore be grateful:	if you would either let me have the
