MEDICAL LIST: FAMILY PRACTITIONER COMMITTEE OF THE AREA HEALTH AUTHORITY FOR Hampshize.

- Providing general medical services in any part of the Family Practitioner Committee's area where the Medical Practitioners undertaking to provide general medical services is already adequate, ie in what is classified as a "restricted" or "intermediate" area. This condition does not apply however to any part of the area in which the partnership has an existing right to establish such premises.
- 2. The effect of this decision is that you can accept and treat patients from any part of the Family Practitioner Committee's area but (except as mentioned in paragraph 1 above) you are precluded from opening a surgery in any part which my Committee have, at the time of you wishing to open a surgery in that part, classified as restricted or intermediate. The Family Practitioner Committee will always tell you, on request, which parts of their area are classified as restricted or intermediate at the time of your enquiry.
- 3. It is open to you to appeal to the Secretary of State for Social Services against the condition referred to in paragraph 1 above. If you wish to do so, you should send your notice of appeal within seven days of receipt of this letter, or such longer period as the Secretary of State may allow, to the Under Secretary of State, Department of Health and Social Security, Division PlD, Eileen House, 80-94 Newington Causeway, Elephant and Castle, London, SEL 6EF.
