He told me that if the Crown Prosecution Service proceeded in H the initial allegation, I would be contacted. I later learned that the CPI had not proceeded because of tack Nevedence. I later took part in the CHI investigations into the case of the Hospital In July of this year I spoke to Dan Clacker prior to a meeting which I understood was to investigate matters funther. I did not hear from him to assumed matters had been dropped. I am currently awarting sight of my husband's medical records duing his stay at the hospital but have not, as yet, lodged any formal complaints or allegations. I should be interested to learn if fuither ation is to be taken and to be advising of any neeting with other relatives
