What was the purpose A1455 behind prescribing oramorph and the dosage? Action 49 TI the two Nurses who administered oramorph on the 21st September AIHS6. 1998 at 14:50 and 20:15. Action 50 TST Doctor LORD, regarding the prescriptions and medicines on page 756 of the records. Ascertain from Doctor LORD why Mr A1457 CUNNINGHAM was prescribed diamorphine, hyoscine, midazalam and metronidozole on 21st September 1998. Action 51 TST Doctor BARTON with regards to medicines that were prescribed as per page 756 in particular diamorphine, hyoscine, midazalam and A1458' metronidozole. Ascertain and clarify with Doctor BARTON the reasons for these prescriptions and in particular on what day were they prescribed and where does this correspond in the medical records. Ascertain and clarify the reasons behind the administration of diamorphine, hyoscine and midazalam in particular on 24th September why is the dose written as 40mg and 60mg given at the same time. What was the reasoning behind the increase in these drugs and where does this correlate to on the Doctors records.

Action 56	TI believed Nurse HALLANN regarding her entry in the medical notes on page 867 on 21 st September 1998. Ascertain and clarify what is recorded.
Action 57	TI author of record on page 867 of medical notes dated 21^{st} September 1998 commences, 'remained agitated until approximately 20:30'. Clarify with author that he or she was the person that administered diamorphine and midazalam on the syringe driver on the first occasion.
Action 58	TST Staff Nurse HALLANN regarding her entry on page 867 of the notes dated 22^{nd} September 1998. Clarify what is recorded and obtain AutLS further explanation.
Action 59	TI author of entry on medical records at the top of page 868 dated 22 nd September 1998, commences 'syringe driver changed at 20:20 hours'. A1466 Ascertain and clarify what has been recorded.

Cross refer the information given to Son in Law Mr FARTHING with the amount of drugs actually given at that time as per the prescription sheet.

Action 62	TST Staff Nurse HAMBLYN regarding her entry on the medical notes on page 869 dated 24^{th} September 1998. Ascertain and clarify what is recorded specifically cross refer this with the prescription chart for the administration of the diamorphine.
Action 63	TST Staff Nurse RING regarding her entries in the medical notes on page 869 dated 25^{th} and 26^{th} September 1998. Ascertain and clarify what is recorded specifically the medications that she had administered, cross refer these to the prescription sheets.
