- Action 1 TST Doctor Vicky BANKS, Consultant in Old Age Psychiatry, Gosport War Memorial Hospital re her involvement with the patient Mr CUNNINGHAM as per page 43 of the notes.
- Action 2 TST Doctor Wendy CHILDS, Senior House Officer to Doctor BANKS re the letter at page 43 of the notes. Ascertain from Doctor CHILDS whether she is the author of the additional hand written notes dated 13th July 1998, if so clarify what these additional entries refer to.
- Action 3 TST Doctor J GROCOCK, Code A believed GP of Mr CUNNINGHAM. Ascertain from Doctor GROCOCK what the medical history of Mr CUNNINGHAM was prior to his admission to Gosport War Memorial Hospital in June 1998.
- Action 4 TI Doctor Scott BROWN, re his involvement with Mr CUNNINGHAM as per page 49. Ascertain and clarify what is recorded on page 49.
- Action 5 TI Shaun GOLDING, Social Worker for Mr CUNNINGHAM as per the entry on the records at page 49. Clarify with Mr GOLDING the circumstances that lead to Mr CUNNINGHAM being admitted to Hospital on 23rd June 1998.
- Action 6 TI Doctor Scott BROWN regarding his entries on the records at page 50, cross refer with Action 4.
- Action 7 TST Doctor LORD, regarding her involvement with the patient Mr CUNNINGHAM in particular clarify and ascertain her involvement with Mr CUNNINGHAM when she saw him at Dolphin Day Hospital on Friday 19th June 1998.
- Action 8 TST Doctor Scott BROWN regarding his entries on the medical notes from page 53 to 59 inclusive. Clarify with Doctor Scott BROWN what the mini mental state examination is and what was conducted on the 23rd June 1998. Clarify and ascertain the entries made on the history sheet on page 59.
- Action 9 TI author of entry as at page 60 of the notes (possibly Doctor Scott BROWN). Entry appears to refer to Mr CUNNINGHAM being reviewed at Alstoke House. Ascertain and clarify with author what has been recorded.

- Action 10 TI author of entry on medical records at page 61, dated 22nd June 1998 clarify what the discrepancies were with regards to the medication as recorded. (Doctors initials appear to be P.E.C).
- Action 11 TST Doctor GROCOCK, regarding telephone call and entry made on the 22nd June 1998 on page 61, regarding the transference of Mr CUNNINGHAM from Merlin Park to Phoenix Day Hospital. Ascertain and clarify what this refers to.
- Action 12 TST Doctor Scott BROWN regarding the entry in the records at page 62, cross refer with Action 9 appears to be a continuation. Clarify why Doctor BROWN only makes an entry in the record every couple of days or weeks.
- Action 13 TI author of entry on page 63 of notes dated 28th August 1998, believed to be Doctor or Nurse BAKER. Ascertain and clarify what has been recorded and what BAKERS involvement was with Mr CUNNINGHAM.
- Action 14 TST Doctor Wendy CHILDS, regarding her entries in the medical notes at pages 65, 66, 67 and 68 of the notes. Ascertain from Doctor CHILDS what her involvement with Mr CUNNINGHAM was. Record and clarify her entries in the notes.
- Action 15 TST Doctor CHILDS, regarding her entries in the notes on page 69.
- Action 16 TST Doctor CHILDS, regarding her entry on page 70 of the notes dated 24th July 1998 and the reference to Mr CUNNINGHAM'S Solicitor. Clarify what these entries refer to.
- Action 17 TST Doctor LORD, regarding her involvement with the patient Brian CUNNINGHAM as per page 70 of the records dated 24th July 1998, 3:15 p.m. discussion with Doctor CHILDS and Doctor LORD reference Parkinson Disease.
- Action 18 TI the author of the entry on the medical notes as at page 71, dated 24th July 1998 has reference to check FBC's. Ascertain and clarify what medication was started appears 30mg. Ascertain and clarify what this medicine was and why it was prescribed.
- Action 19 TI author of entry on page 72 of notes dated 26th July 1998 timed 03:30 also entries in the notes on 27th July 1998 on page 73. Author believed to an enrolled Nurse. Ascertain and clarify from this Nurse what her involvement with Mr CUNNINGHAM was.
- Action 20 TST Doctor LORD, Geriatrician regarding her entries in the notes at page 74, dated 27th July 1998. Ascertain and clarify what has been recorded. Clarify with Doctor LORD what the purpose of the Care Plan was.

- Action 21 TST Doctor Wendy CHILDS, regarding her entries in the medical notes as at page 75. Ascertain and clarify what has been recorded. In particular interested in the use of the ward round stamp, how often is this used.
- Action 22 TST believed Doctor Ruth DEVERILL, regarding her entry in the medical note at page 75 dated 27th July 1998 believed to be a speech and language therapist. Clarify what is recorded in the entry and what the purpose of her involvement with Mr CUNNINGHAM was.
- Action 23 TST Staff Nurse Jo TAYLOR, regarding her entries in the medical notes from pages 72 onwards. Ascertain from Staff Nurse TAYLOR what her involvement with Mr CUNNINGHAM was.
- Action 24 TST Doctor CHILDS, regarding her entry on page 77 of the notes, dated 30th July 1998.
- Action 25 TST Doctor BAKER, regarding his entry on page 81 dated 5th August 1998 commences 'review by Doctor BAKER'. Ascertain and clarify what the effect of this review was and what the Care Plan for Mr CUNNINGHAM was.
- Action 26 TST Doctor BAKER, regarding his entry on the notes at page 83 dated 10th August 1998 ward round. Ascertain and clarify what has been recorded.
- Action 27 TST Doctor BANKS, regarding her involvement with Mr CUNNINGHAM in particular the entry in the notes at page 83 that refers to a Power of Attorney in respect of Mr CUNNINGHAM. What does this refer to?
- Action 28 TST Shaun GOLDING, Social Services, regarding his continued involvement with Mr CUNNINGHAM in August of 1998 as per the entry at page 83.
- Action 29 TST Doctor MONROE, regarding his entry in the medical notes on page 87, dated 17th August 1998 titled 'Ward Round'. Clarify with Doctor MONROE what his involvement with Mr CUNNINGHAM was.
- Action 30 TST Doctor BAKER, regarding his entries in the notes at page 90 and 91, dated 27th August 1998 referring to ward round. Clarify and ascertain what Doctor BAKER'S involvement was at that time.
- Action 31 TST Doctor LORD, regarding her entry in the medical notes at pages 91 and 92 and her review of Mr CUNNINGHAM on 27th August 1998.
- Action 32 TI the author of entries on page 93 of the notes, dated 11th September, 24th September and 28th September 1998. Ascertain and clarify what has been recorded and the reasons why there are only three entries

between the 11th and 28th September. For the entry dated 24th September, what is meant by the term 'Discharge from Case Load' (author appears to be C.P.N initials).

- Action 33 TST Doctor LORD, regarding her letter at page 97 of the medical records.
- Action 34 TST Doctor Ruth DEVERILL, Speech and Language Therapist, regarding her report at page 101 of the medical records.
- Action 35 TST Doctor LORD, regarding the letter at pages 105 and 107 of the medical records.
- Action 36 TST Doctor LORD, regarding her letter to Doctor GROCOCK as at page 111 and 113 dated 22nd July 1998.
- Action 37 TST Doctor Mary Scott BROWN, Staff Grade Psychiatrist to Doctor BANKS regarding her letter to Doctor GROCOCK on 8th July 1998 as at pages 117 and 119. Ascertain and clarify what the purpose of this letter was.
- Action 38 TST Christine HEADITCH, Administrator to the Nursing Home Inspection Unit reference the letter on page 313 of the medical notes. What concerns has been brought to their attention by Mr FARTHING.
- Action 39 TST Doctor LORD, regarding the letter on page 457 of the Nursing Records dated 23rd September. This letter refers to the final admittance of Mr CUNNINGHAM to Gosport War Memorial Hospital in September 1998. Ascertain and clarify the circumstances surrounding this letter.
- Action 41 TST Doctor LORD, regarding her letter of 22nd June 1998 as at page 491 to 496 inclusive, put this letter into context with other letters she has written regarding the treatment of Mr CUNNINGHAM during the last six months of his life.
- Action 42 TST Doctor GROCOCK, regarding his entry in the medical records at page 501, a letter regarding Mr CUNNINGHAM dated 11th June 1998.
- Action 43 TST Doctor LORD, regarding her entries in the medical notes at pages 642 and 643 in relation to the admittance of Mr CUNNINGHAM to Gosport War Memorial Hospital on 21st September 1998. Ascertain and clarify what is recorded, the Care Plan to be followed and the reasons for this. As a result of the entry on page 643 did Doctor LORD prescribe the medicines to be taken by Mr CUNNINGHAM subsequently? Did Doctor LORD have any involvement in the prescribing of the medicines in September for Mr CUNNINGHAM.
- Action 44 TST Doctor Jane BARTON, regarding her entry in the medical notes at page 643 dated 24th September 1998. Ascertain and clarify what has

been recorded. Clarify with Doctor BARTON why the entry is dated 24th following an entry made by Doctor LORD on the 21st.

- Action 45 TST Doctor BARTON regarding her entry on page 645 of the medical notes dated 21st September 1998. Ascertain and clarify what has been recorded.
- Action 46 TST Doctor BROOK regarding his entry in the medical notes at page 645, first dated 25th September, 2nd dated 28th September. Clarify what his involvement with the patient Mr CUNNINGHAM was. In particular clarify the discussions that he had with Doctor LORD regarding the completion of the death certificate as noted at the foot of the page.
- Action 47 TST Staff Nurse Beverley TURNBULL, regarding her entry in the medical notes at page 645 dated 26th September 1998, where she verifies the death of Mr CUNNINGHAM. Ascertain and clarify what's been recorded.
- Action 48 TST Doctor LORD, regarding her entry on the prescription sheets on page 752, regarding prescription of oramorph. What was the purpose behind prescribing oramorph and the dosage?
- Action 49 TI the two Nurses who administered oramorph on the 21st September 1998 at 14:50 and 20:15.
