Re: <u>Operation Rochester</u>, <u>Investigation into Deaths at Gosport War</u> <u>Memorial Hospital</u>

Following my letter of the 4th September 2004, and our subsequent telephone conversation in respect of the proposed interviews with Dr Barton, could you please confirm that you have received pre interview disclosure in the form of medical notes of Elsie Devine and an explanatory note thereon summarising the care/treatment afforded to this lady prior to her death on 21st November 1999.

The note also details the proposed general subject areas to be covered during the course of the opening background interview with your client.

I should inform you that the cause of death as recorded on Mrs Devines death certificate is chronic renal failure and chronic glomerulongprhritis.
