I understand that Gillian McKENZIE contacted you on 25th November regarding Code A and raising concerns that I am not responding to her calls.

The level of contact with Mrs McKenzie has remained high throughout 2004.

There are 72 recorded contacts between OP ROCHESTER Staff and Mrs McKenzie throughout 2004...16 of these contacts have been made during October and November 2004... I have spoken with her personally on 16th September and 4th October and have also updated her legal representative Mr Ken WHITE of Cornfield Law. I have received further messages from making observations about her mothers case on my answer-phone which have been noted.

Nigel NIVEN wrote to Mrs McKenzie on 24th November 2004 informing her that work in respect of her case was ongoing.

( Given the extensive concerns raised by Mrs McKenzie regarding the care afforded to her mother Glady's RICHARDS we have had the case further independently reviewed by the legal medico lawyer who has recommended that the papers be sent to the final reviewing experts..however they are looking at priority cases first. I would not expert them to commence work on the RICHARDS case until early next year).

Earlier in the year Mrs McKENZIE was speaking to various members of the Operation ROCHESTER team and as a result was not receiving a consistency of response.
