> IPCC Commissioner Rebecca Marsh has now met all six complainants to > update them on the progress of their complaints and the IPCC can > confirm that the meetings were productive and covered all the issues > the complainants wished to raise.

> Mrs Marsh will now consider the forces recommendations with regard to > the findings of the Hampshire investigation into the complaints and > the additional information provided by the complainants at their > recent meetings with her. A decision will be made in a few weeks time > and the Commissioner will confirm this in writing to each of the six > complainants detailing the outcome of the review of the > recommendations regarding misconduct.

> "The meetings I have had with each of the six complainants to update > them on how their complaint has been handled by the IPCC and what > happens next were very positive.

> "I have a considerable amount of additional information to consider > following those meetings and will need a few weeks before making a > decision, " Mrs Marsh said.
