Sir

I took a call from Ms Margaret Ward at 1300 hrs today 24/2/06. She is the daughter of Mrs Windsor. She informs me that there has been publicity on Meridian TV News last night and on front page of today's Portsmouth News regarding the Police Complaints Authority and the release of the number of cases we are investigating (15) amongst other things

She was surprised that she had not heard from **Code A** regarding the matter. She has apparently not been able to contact **Code A** on her mobile, hence her call to me.

I informed her that we had not seen the publicity so we were unable to comment on it. I did also inform her that you had been out of the country so it was unlikely that any information had come from the enquiry. She now understands that we have no control over comments made by another body.

She says that she had a letter from the enquiry last year and last spoke to **Code A** December 2005. She has no complaints at all with **Code C** nor the enquiry as a whole, but is upset that information has been put into the public domain without her knowing about it beforehand. She says that she hopes that no other families were aware of this publicity. I have pointed out that it is unlikely to be the case.
